Comprises four distinct housing areas with 6 primary schools and Dorcan Academy secondary school. Parish has a greater proportion than Swindon average in employment such as operative and administrative, and considerably less than average of professionals living in the area. We actively seek to discover and develop gifts and skills in our membership. We have improved our delegation to enable people to develop. We are seeking to appoint a children’s and youth worker through SWYM. Please pray as we interview a candidate. We have 2 people attending the Deanery Growing Leaders course. We have a project director for our re ordering and are seeking to appoint another one.
